Natrona County Parks would like to announce the opportunity for citizens of the County to cut and collect firewood from Ponderosa Park on Casper Mountain. Over 1200 trees have been cut down in response to the fire that occurred several years ago. These trees are available to be cut into firewood and hauled out.

Ponderosa Park has difficult access and narrow roads. A few turnarounds have been created to help facilitate firewood collection. Parks will allow no more than 3 truck and trailer setups in at a time. The schedule will be setup in 2 day blocks until the weather prevents safe access.

Parks requires the following of all participants:

- Firewood collection is during daylight hours only
- No off-road travel
- Try to coordinate with other parties in the area.
- Only fallen trees may be collected as firewood
- Fallen trees cannot be left within 10' of edge of road
- Limbs and debris left over from firewood collection must be cleared from the road.

You must sign a liability waiver and schedule with the Parks Department to collect these trees as firewood. Please visit the Parks office to get on the schedule and sign waivers for all persons in your work party.
